Passau, Racklau / Winterhafen



Please note: The scheduled docking location may change at short notice. Local harbour authorities may assign several ships to the same berth thus your ship may be tied up behind another ship. If you cannot find your ship, please contact the <u>tour manager</u> number indicated in this booklet. You will find out the docking station for disembarkation from your cruise manager on the last evening.

Please plan to arrive in a timely manner in order to respect the scheduled **embarkation** at **4:00 pm**. If you arrive later, please let us know in time. The ship must depart on time.

Please note that an earlier embarkation is not possible for organisational reasons. If necessary, however, you may deposit your luggage on board already from 2 pm onwards.

Please label all pieces of luggage with a luggage tag, making sure that it has your name, cabin number and the ships name on it.

3. Tour Details

Accompanied by a cruise ship you cycle along Europe's second largest river Danube from the charming Bavarian "three river city" of Passau straight into the heart of the once glorious Imperial and Royal Monarchy. Enjoy three of the most enchanting European capitals: the lively Vienna, the Slovak coronation city of Bratislava at the foot of the Carpathian Mountains and Budapest, the "Hungarian Danube Queen"! By bicycle you discover the stunning natural spectacle of the Schlögener Donauschlinge ("Great Loop"), the legendary Wachau with romantic towns and mighty castles amidst lovely vineyards, the untouched alluvial forests of the Danube National Park, as well as the picturesque Hungarian Danube bend where the important cupola of the basilica in Esztergom salutes from the distance. The highlights of the tour: Passau, the City of 3 rivers, the Schloegen Danube Loop, the Hungarian Danube Bend, the World Heritage Site Wachau, the metropoles of Bratislava, Budapest and Vienna.

Day 1: Passau – Engelhartszell

Arrival in the "Three River City". Passau attracts many with the world's greatest church organ at the Stephansdom and its charming Old Town. Embarkation will be around 4:00 pm, departure around 7 pm. Enjoy your first dinner on board and an evening sail to Engelhartszell.

Day 2: Engelhartszell - Great Loop -Brandstatt, ca. 43 - 49 km

The day starts in Engelhartszell (the only Trappist monastery in Austria), where we head towards the "Great Loop" - one of the most beautiful and original sectors of the Danube. Your cycling will encounter small villages and cosy must-see taverns. You'll board again in Brandstatt. Then, you "sail into the night" towards Bratislava.

Day 3: Bratislava, ca. 53 km

Arrival at Bratislava. You start cycling from Bratislava via Hainburg to the imposing Imperial Palace of Hof beautifully terraced gardens and idyllic manor farm further on to

Devin and then back to Bratislava. Tip: discover the hidden alleys of Bratislava, places and all the sights of this ambitious metropolis during a tour by mini train and by foot. In the night shipping to Budapest.

Day 4: Budapest (day of rest) or roundtrip to Szentendre, ca. 48 km

In the early morning, you enjoy the panoramic view of the Danube's gorgeous landscape on the Sundeck. The gateway to Budapest is overwhelming, as many of the famous tourist features are situated directly next to the river bank. In the afternoon you can explore the numerous attractions of the city. Nearby, you find the Margaretheninsel which is outstandingly qualified for a small bike tour or the charming town of Szentendre with Mediterranean atmosphere and lively art life. In the night shipping to Vác.



Day 5: Danube Bend | Vác – Esztergom, ca. 48 km

The Danube bend is definitely one of most delightful and attractive parts and is called the Hungarian Wachau. Today's bike leg starts at the baroque village of Vác, which has been influenced by the architects of the austrian empress Maria Theresia. Cycling through the picturesque and gently undulating countryside your route leads you directly to the bishop-town of Esztergom, with its gorgeous basilica – Hungary's largest Catholic Church – overlooking the village. In the night shipping to Vienna.

Day 6: Vienna-Nussdorf (day of rest)

You should be sure to see the most famous places of interest like the St. Stephens Cathedral, the Hofburg, the gorgeous boulevard "Ringstraße" with the Burgtheater, the State Opera House or the town hall that takes you back to the past. In the night shipping to Rossatz or Dürnstein (Wachau).

Day 7: Wachau – Melk – Pöchlarn, ca. 40 - 50 km

Your last biking day is a special highlight! Amidst small dreamy villages, apricot trees, vineyards, castles, monasteries and ruins, this gentle hilly landscape enchants everybody. A powerful ruin looms above the small Baroque town of Dürnstein, while the blue tower of the monastery church is a landmark of Wachau. In the small village of Pöchlarn you will board again. After the farewell gala dinner, you start "sailing" back to Passau.

Day 8: Departure from Passau

Every journey draws to an end. Once again you enjoy on deck the first sunbeams and the peaceful silence of the Danube Valley. Take a last sight at the Schlögener Schlinge ("Great Loop") before you arrive relaxed at Passau.

Arrival: approx. at 10 am, disembarkation half an hour later.

4. Optional Excursions

Bratislava: City Tour by by Mini Train, Sunday, approx. 5:00 - 7:00 pm

On this tour, we will introduce you to the cultural, economical and political centre of Slowakia. The excursion starts with an interesting city tour by mini train. Then continue your discovery tour by foot with our tour guide. It leads you through the enchanting Old Town, which has many lovingly restored historic buildings and shines now in new splendour. You will get back to the mooring place where the round trip ends. The program can be subject to change.

BUDAPEST: City tour by bike – Cycle Budapest! Monday, approx. 09:30 am – 12:30 pm

Also in Budapest, it is possible to explore the city by bike. Discover the most beautiful sites of the Danube metropolis as close as you can get. An experienced guide will take you to see the many sites: The tour starts directly from the ship. You will cycle alongside the Danube River up to the Margaret Bridge where you can enjoy marvellous views. Arriving in Pest, you cycle past the World Heritage Site Andrássy Avenue, the Opera House, the F. Liszt Square and the former Parisian Warehouse up to the Heroes' Square with two impressive art museums. In the City Park, you cycle along the Vajdahunyad Castle and the world-famous Szechenyi Spa. On your way back, you will stop over at another viewpoint on the Danube, from where you can enjoy the panorama with the most important sights of Buda such as the Royal Palace, St Matthew 's Cathedral and the Fisherman's Bastion. Finally, you cross the world-famous Chain Bridge back to the ship.

Duration: about 3 – 3,5 hours, approx. 12 km

BUDAPEST: Budapest at night with Hungarian folklore dance show, Monday, approx. 8:00 – 11:00 pm

At the dock, a bus picks you up and takes you to a typical Hungarian restaurant, where you will be welcomed with a traditional schnapps and the famous gipsy music. Enjoy a folk performance full of fiery temperament, try some of Hungary's white or red wines and the typical Hungarian Goulash Soup. But, if you have not seen Budapest at night in the sea of lights, you have really missed something! Enjoy the panoramic ride through the illuminated city to a viewpoint – from there you will have a beautiful view of the city. Returning at about 11:00 pm.

VIENNA: Walking tour through the city centre with bus transfer service from/back to the dock, Wednesday, approx. 2:00 – 5:00 pm

Experience the charming and loveable city of Vienna on a two-hour walking tour with an experienced local guide. Vienna is not only the declared favourite city of all gourmets: Vienna is where history meets modern life and design meets tradition. The bus takes you from the ship to the famous Viennese boulevard "Ringstraße", past the State Opera House, the Parliament, the Burg Theatre, and the University. Get off at the Imperial Palace (Hofburg) and walk towards St Stephen`s Cathedral, Austria's highest church. From here, start for a relaxing walking tour to the Graben, Vienna`s major square, and via the Imperial Palace (Hofburg) with the Joseph's Square and the Spanish Riding School reach the Albertina Square. Bus transfer via Ringstraße back to the ship. If you prefer, you may also stay in the city centre.

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VIENNA: City tour by bike, Wednesday, approx. 2:00 – 5:00 pm

Get up close and personal with Vienna's famous sites ...

One of the nicest ways to discover Vienna. The bike tour will offer you close-up looks of the impressive Viennese buildings. Accompanied by an experienced local guide, enjoy the beauty of architecture and culture in small groups. From Nussdorf, cycle along the Danube Canal via Spitteldorf and Urania to the Hundertwasser House and to the major sights, including the State Opera House, the Johann Strauss Memorial in the City Park, the Imperial Palace (the former Habsburg winter residence), and the New City Hall. The tour ends at St. Stephen's Cathedral, Vienna's best-known landmark. Several stopovers for picture taking.
