Day 2 (full day) | **Visit to Keukenhof** approx. 6 hours

After an escorted transfer, the most beautiful spring park in the world awaits you today. Millions of hyacinths, daffodils and, of course, tulips in every imaginable colour delight several million visitors to the 32-hectare park every year.

After a short orientation walk, you will have around 3 hours to explore the park on your own before embarking on the unaccompanied return journey to the ship at around

14:00. **Meals are provided in the form of a packed lunch.**

Day 3 (M) | **Rotterdam | City tour and harbour cruise** approx. 3.5 hours

Discover Rotterdam on a multifaceted walking tour! With an enthusiastic guide you will visit the highlights of the centre of Rotterdam, which has been voted the best city centre in the Netherlands. You will see architectural icons such as the cube houses, Central Station, Timmerhaus, the Market Hall and Europe's first skyscraper. After the tour, an exciting 75-minute boat trip takes you through the world's largest seaport, past ultra-modern facilities for the transfer of containers. After the boat trip, you make your own way back to the pier.

Day 3 (A) | **Rotterdam | Delft city tour with transfer** approx. 3 hours

Delft, a city lined with canals and famous for its beautiful blue porcelain, is only a 30-minute bus journey from Rotterdam. During your tour of the historic centre, you will experience the city's glorious past and stroll along the canals, churches, mansions and courtyards. Afterwards, you will return to the jetty with many new impressions.

Day 4 (M) | **Antwerp | City tour with transfer** approx. 3 hours

Antwerp is a city on a human scale: most of the sights are within walking distance of each other. A walk through the city is therefore the best way to get to know Antwerp. The metropolis on the Scheldt is also the hometown of Rubens, Van Dyck, Plantin and Moretus and boasts one of the largest Gothic cathedrals in the world. During your tour, which begins with a short transfer from the ship to the city centre, you will walk around some of the most important sights: Guild Houses, the Brabo Fountain, the Cathedral of Our Lady (exterior visit) and the romantic Vlaeykensgang.

Day 5 ^(M) | Nijmegen | City Walk approx. 2 hours

This guided city walk is the perfect way to journey through many years of the past. Nijmegen not only impresses with its cosy and lively atmosphere, but also with its charming historic buildings, centuries-old squares and the oldest shopping street in Holland: the Lange Hezelstraat.

This tour starts and ends at the jetty.

Day 5 ^(A) | Nijmegen | Brewery visit with tasting approx. 2.5 hours *

After a short walk you will reach the De Hemel brewery. Not only the beer, but also the people, the brewing process and the technology behind it make De Hemel heaven! The tour is rounded off with a tasting of 6 beers! This is followed by a leisurely walk back to the jetty!
