Day 2 (M) | Rotterdam city tour & harbour cruise approx. 3.5 h

Discover Rotterdam on a multifaceted walking tour! With an enthusiastic guide, you will visit the highlights of the centre of Rotterdam, which has been voted the best city centre in the Netherlands. You will see architectural icons such as the cube houses, Central Station, Timmerhaus, the Market Hall and Europe's first skyscraper. After the tour, an exciting 75-minute boat trip takes you through the world's largest seaport, past ultramodern facilities for the transfer of containers. After the boat trip, you make your own way back to the pier.

Day 3 (M) |Ghent | Bruges City tour with transfer approx. 4.5 h € 50.00

In the morning, we offer you the opportunity to discover Bruges, also known as the Venice of the North, on a city tour. Experience the city's characteristic canals, bridges, cobbled streets and medieval buildings. Stroll through the historic city centre past the imposing bell tower, majestic churches and old windmills.

Day 3 (A) |Ghent | Light and shadow tour approx. 3 h

At dusk, the charming city of Ghent will enchant you on this tour. After a short transfer your guide will take you on a stroll through the historic city centre and you will learn interesting facts about the centuries-old buildings. Architectural accents, streets, monuments and squares are artfully enveloped in an enchanting atmosphere, transforming Ghent into a magical evening landscape of light and shadow.

Day 4 (A) | Antwerp | City tour with transfer approx. 3 h

This afternoon you will spend exploring the diamond city of Antwerp. Antwerp is a city on a human scale: most of the sights are within walking distance of each other. A walk through the city is therefore the best way to get to know Antwerp. The metropolis on the Scheldt is also the hometown of Rubens, Van Dyck, Plantin and Moretus and boasts one of the largest Gothic cathedrals in the world. During your tour, which begins with a short transfer from the ship to the city centre, you will walk around some of the most important sights: Guild Houses, the Brabo Fountain, the Cathedral of Our Lady (exterior visit) and the romantic Vlaeykensgang.

Day 5 (full day) | Brussels | City tour with transfer approx. 6.5 h

Brussels, a city that knows how to delight and surprise its visitors. It owes its cosmopolitan character to its position as the capital of Europe. Let yourself be enchanted by the Art Nouveau streetscape as you marvel at St. Michael's Cathedral and the Hubertus Galleries, stroll through the Grand Market with its guild houses in the heart of the old town and finally get to know the famous landmark of Brussels: it is only half a metre tall and goes by the name of 'Manneken Pis'.
