Vintner and vineyards on the Moselle

Day 2 (M) | Koblenz | Ehrenbreitstein approx. 2.5 hours*

Accompanied by your tour guide, waft in a cable car up to the fortress. Ehrenbreitstein Fortress, situated on the rocky spur above the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers, is now part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site 'Upper Middle Rhine Valley'. The complex is part of a system of military fortifications around the city of Koblenz, but not only boasts 5,000 years of history, but also a magnificent panorama and a lively cultural centre with interesting exhibitions. During the one-hour guided tour, you will experience how history comes to life at original historical sites, from Roman fortifications to knights' castles and Prussian fortifications. The return journey is made individually by cable car and a walk back to the ship.

Day 2 (A) | Koblenz | WineWalkTour approx. 2 hours

Wine and Koblenz - these two components simply belong together! Why? Find out for yourself: Travel with your tour guide through the history of wine in a city that lies in the centre of the famous wine-growing region of Rhineland-Palatinate. Stroll along the most spectacular sights and be inspired by historical anecdotes. And because the history of wine needs to be experienced with all your senses, you can taste three regional wines at special locations on the 'WineWalk' tour. Of course, you can keep the wine glasses as a souvenir!

Day 3 (M) | Zell | Covered wagon tour with wine tasting approx. 2.5 hours

Welcome to Zell, the home of the 'Zeller Schwarze Katz'! To find out more about winegrowing and the landscape, you start a covered wagon ride directly from the pier to the Königslay-Terrassen vantage point. From here you have a wonderful view over millions of vines and the largest wine-growing community on the Moselle. You will learn more about the secrets of the 'Zeller Schwarze Katz' and of course taste three of the local wines.

Day 4 (M) | Bernkastel-Kues | Panorama tour with wine tasting approx. 3 hours

Together with your guide, you will first stroll through the cosy and historic Bernkastel. You will then travel through idyllic Moselle villages and vineyards to the 'Moselberge'. During the journey, you can take in the typical landscape and learn amusing stories and interesting facts about the region. You can enjoy a small refreshment while visiting a Roman wine press. This excursion is rounded off with a wine tasting 'Wine & Health' by a wine lecturer.

Day 5 (M) | Traben-Trarbach | Underworld tour and wine tasting approx. 2.5 hours **€ 40.00**

The town of Traben-Trarbach was known as one of the most important wine trading towns around 1900. As part of today's special tour, you will have the opportunity to visit various historic cellars. In the mystical semi-darkness, you will learn exciting facts about the historic viticulture and old cellar technology as well as interesting facts about the winery industry and the wine trade of today. Afterwards you will taste 4 exquisite wines in a unique atmosphere.

**! The temperature in the cellar is around 12 degrees, so please bring warm clothing!
In addition, the cellars are only partially accessible, it is not possible to bring a walking frame!**

Day 6 (M) | Cochem | Cochem and wine approx. 2.5 hours **€ 40.00**

A guided tour during which you will not only learn interesting facts about the history of Cochem and its many sights, but which will also introduce you to the town's wine culture. This special tour begins with a glass of sparkling wine, after which you will accompany your guide through Cochem's history and learn, for example, which grape varieties are grown on the Moselle, what the Bockbrunnen fountain has to do with wine and you will also visit the three 'Cochem originals'. At the end of the tour, you will taste three special Moselle wines from Cochem's winegrowers at one of the town's most beautiful vantage points.
