

Day 1 Düsseldorf

Individual arrival in Düsseldorf and embarkation. Our cruise management will welcome you with a glass of sparkling wine.

Day 2 Düsseldorf - Cologne - Andernach

In the early morning, your ship will leave the Rhine metropolis and take you to Cologne.

The fourth-largest city in Germany, Cologne is famous for its cathedral. Get to know the city on a tour that combines a coach tour and a guided walk (optional). During the tour, you will see the City Hall, the Staple House, the Gürzenich, a historic building and ballroom, the Eigelstein City Gate Castle and more. Around noon, your ship will set sail for Andernach. Take the opportunity to have a break in the saloon or enjoy the first sunrays on the sundeck.

Day 3 Andernach - Koblenz

The town on the Middle Rhine is primarily famous for an impressing spectacle of nature. Join us to see the world's highest cold-water geyser (optional). The excursion will start with a visit to the Geyser Centre. In a special setting, you will learn all about the exciting world of geysers and volcanoes. Afterwards, the shuttle boat will take you to the Namedyer Werth peninsula down the river. After arriving, you will walk for about 300 metres through the nature reserve to reach the place where the geyser erupts. Here you can marvel at the up to 60-metre-high geyser fountain.

Day 4 Koblenz - Rüdesheim

Get to know Koblenz from a different side. On an optional excursion about the wine and sparkling wine history of Koblenz, stroll past the sights of the town, and reaching the sparkling wine museum, round off the tour with a glass of fine sparkling wine. In the afternoon, your ship will continue its journey to reach Rüdesheim.

Day 5 Rüdesheim

A top destination on a Rhine journey, Rüdesheim is one of the most visited wine towns along the German Rhine River Valley, world-famous for its Drosselgasse, a vivid alley lined with traditional wine taverns. In the morning, learn everything about the rich history, and listen to fascinating stories and legends about this river town on a guided walking tour (optional). A colourful afternoon awaits you. A little Winzerexpress train will take you from the cruise dock directly to the "RheinWeinWelt", a wine store in a particular location. After a short introduction, you can choose which of the many wines you would like to sample. To round off the indulgence cruise, the captain will invite you for the Gala-Dinner. Enjoy this first-class dinner while your ship will be sailing to Frankfurt.

Day 6 Frankfurt

After breakfast, disembarkation will take place and afterwards individual journey home.



On board our premium ship MS SE-MANON, you will enjoy a relaxed and cosy atmosphere.

After sightseeing, you can decide whether you prefer to use the small inviting spa area with sauna and whirlpool or curl up with a book in the small library. You may also choose to relax in the saloon with panoramic windows or on the sun deck. In the restaurant, where panoramic windows offer stunning views over the passing scenery, will be served some fine food. You can round off the evenings in the saloon, having a glass of wine or beer and listening to relaxing music.

The spacious sun deck is partly shaded and features plenty of deck chairs and loungers.

A special highlight is the outdoor pool at the aft of the ship (8.70 m x 4.50 m, open approx. from May to August, depending on the weather).

There is an elevator running between the middle deck, the foyer and the restaurant. The upper deck and the sun deck are accessible by stair lift. The main deck is only accessible by stairs.


The ship is not wheelchair accessible. Smoking is only permitted on the sundeck, it is not permitted to smoke in any indoor area of the ship.

All 74 cabins are outside cabins (approx.14 m²) and are comfortably furnished with hotel-style beds and ensuite facilities with shower* (*cabin 306, 307, 308, 309 with bathtub) featuring hair dryer, satellite TV, safe, internal telephone line, and individually adjustable air conditioning.

Upper deck: cabins featuring French balconies (= floor-to-ceiling sliding glass doors)

Middle deck: The huge panoramic windows can be opened.

Main deck: The small windows cannot be opened (Height approx. 40 cm).

Optional Excursion Program We would be happy to send you an order form with our offer on excursions prior to departure. The excursions will be held in German language. The excursions can only be booked in English language on request (depending on the excursion agency and the minimum number of participants).

Itinerary and program are subject to change at any time. If, for example, due to low or high water levels or bad weather conditions a route cannot be sailed, the captain reserves the right to alter the itinerary for your safety. (No legal right shall arise in either situation). The same shall apply for repair or maintenance works on locks and bridges ordered by river and other local authorities with little or no advance.

Important notice Please consider that on the one hand your ship is your holiday hotel, on the other hand, however, it is an engine that has to run constantly – even at night-time (this includes passing under bridges or through locks). We recommend that passengers that are particularly noise-sensitive, bring along earplugs. When passing through locks, a certain level of noise is inevitable. Please note: during low water conditions, it may become necessary to empty the pool to reduce the weight of the ship. As a result, the pool may not be accessible.

Travel documents EU-citizens (without special situations like dual citizenship, main residence abroad or a limited-validity passport) are required to have a valid passport or ID-card, not expiring within six (6) months of the return of your cruise. We kindly ask non-EU citizens, EU-nationals with multiple citizenship or anybody who has to respect special legal entry requirements for the country to visit, to inform about visa and entry documents at the competent embassy.

This trip is not suitable for guests with reduced mobility.

We recommend that you take out a foreign travel health insurance with repatriation coverage, an accident insurance, a luggage insurance and a travel cancellation insurance.
