Day 2 (M) | Krems | City tour and apricot experience approx. 3 h **€ 70.00**

Today your guide will walk you through the fifth largest city in Lower Austria, which has churches, museums, historic buildings, a charming historic centre and monuments to offer. Then you will drive to an apricot farm where, after a short walk along the apricot adventure trail, you will taste typical Wachau apricot products and see for yourself how versatile this wonderful fruit is!

Day 3 (M) | Vienna | City tour/walk approx. 3 h **€ 50.00**

Known for its coffee houses and above-average quality of life, the capital of Austria welcomes you. The magnificent Ringstrasse with its architecturally impressive buildings is just as much a part of your tour as the State Opera House, where the famous Vienna Opera Ball takes place. From the heart of the city, you'll take a leisurely stroll past Vienna's landmark, St Stephen's Cathedral and the Riding School. Your walk ends back at the Opera House, where the coach is waiting to take you back to the MS SE-MANON.

Day 4 (M) | Esztergom | Danube Bend approx. 5 h **€ 65.00**

This excursion starts in Esztergom. The eye-catcher of the former capital is the impressive basilica, which was modelled on St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. After visiting the cathedral, you will travel through the charming countryside to Visegrad. Your destination is the city's stronghold, from where you can enjoy a marvellous panorama of the meandering Danube, the so-called Danube Bend, and the mountain landscape beyond. Afterwards, a Hungarian lunch in a typical restaurant will fortify you for the onward journey to Budapest, where your ship awaits you.

Day 4 (A) | Budapest | City tour/walk approx. 3 h **€ 40.00**

Budapest, a multifaceted capital divided into two parts by the majestic Danube, welcomes you. Today you will get to know both sides, Buda with its romantic alleyways and Pest, known for its vibrant lifestyle. Heroes' Square, the neo-Gothic Parliament, unique bridges, historic churches and a visit to the market hall are just some of the highlights of today's excursion.

Day 4 (Evening) | Budapest | Budapest by night approx. 3 h **€ 60.00**

A folklore evening in a traditional restaurant with lively folk music awaits you. A good Hungarian white or red wine and Hungarian goulash soup are of course a must! To round off the evening, you will enjoy a lights tour, during which you will have a spectacular view of the glowing city from a vantage point.

Day 5 (M) | Budapest | Puszta Tour approx. 4.5 h**€ 70.00**

This excursion takes you south of Budapest to Lajosmizse, the gateway to the Great Plain. You will be welcomed at the stud farm with schnapps and savoury cakes. A ride in a carriage will give you an overview of the size of the estate. You will then experience a fascinating horse show and have the opportunity to visit the stables. At the end of this eventful day, you will enjoy wine and Hungarian specialities at the Csárda before the coach takes you back to your cruise ship.

Day 6 (M) | Bratislava | Castle, railway and croissants approx. 3 h**€ 45.00**

Bratislava is an insider tip in the East-Central European border triangle. Today you will experience the absolute highlights! First you ride with a charming old-timer- train up to Bratislava Castle and enjoy a wonderful panoramic view of the city from the castle hill. Back in the city, the leisurely city tour leads you through the historic city centre and ends with a taste of the famous Bratislava Kipferl on the main square. Only a short trip along the beautiful promenade of the Danube will take you back to the MS SE-MANON.

Day 7 (M) | Melk | Melk Abbey approx. 2 h**€ 55.00**

After a short transfer, you will reach Melk Abbey, one of the most magnificent Baroque buildings in Europe. During the one-hour guided tour, you will visit the museum, the marble hall and the library. In fine weather, a short detour through the abbey garden is worth your while. You are guaranteed an unforgettable view of the Danube valley from Melk Abbey!
